


POPULATION DISTRIBUTION




FORMAL AND INFORMAL OCCUPATION



INCOME CLASSIFICATION




UNEMPLOYMENT RATE BY SEX







HISTORICAL VARIATION IN EMPLOYMENT










The electricity sector accounts for the largest percentage of workers with incomes above five minimum wages.

























Juárez cycle 2023 - 2024














INCOME BY MUNICIPALITY
Municipal comparison in MP - 2024

















BORDER PORT

Infrastructure equipped with personnel, facilities, equipment, and specialized procedures to control the flow of pedestrians, vehicles, personal property, and merchandise between two countries.

CRIME INCIDENCE

Alleged occurrence of crimes recorded in preliminary investigations initiated or investigation files, reported by the Attorney General's Offices and the Attorney General's Offices of the states involved in the case.

CONSTANT PRICES / REAL PRICES

We refer to constant prices as those that serve as a reference at a given time for comparison with subsequent prices. They are also known as base-year prices.

CURRENT PRICES / NOMINAL PRICES

We refer to current prices as current prices.

ECONOMIC ACTIVITY SECTOR

Classification of the activity to which an economic unit is dedicated according to the division of the economic area: primary (agricultural production), secondary (manufacturing and industry) and tertiary (services).

ECONOMIC GROWTH

Increase in utility, or the value of final goods and services, produced by an economy (of a country or region) in a specific period of time (frequently one year).

ECONOMIC UNIT

The economic unit is the place or entity where economic activities are carried out. This entity or unit can be a factory, office, bank, currency exchange office, school, hospital, repair shop, transportation company, etc.

ECONOMICALLY ACTIVE POPULATION (EAP)

People aged 15 and over who were involved in economic activity or sought it during the reference week and were therefore employed or unemployed.

EQUILIBRIUM INTERBANK INTEREST RATE (EIBER)

Reference rate for credit transactions between banking institutions. This rate is determined by the Bank of Mexico based on quotes submitted by the credit institutions themselves.

EMPLOYED POPULATION

People aged 15 and over who engaged in some economic activity for at least one hour during the reference week. Includes employed persons who had a job.

EMPLOYMENT

understood as the occupation or job that a person performs in a work unit, which confers the status of employee, or from the employer's point of view, as someone who occupies a job position, generating employment, as a synonym for work.

EXPORT

Sell of a product or service to a foreign country for commercial purposes. These shipments are regulated by a series of legal provisions and tax controls that serve as a contextual framework for trade relations between countries.

FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT (FDI)

It is an agreement whose purpose is to create a lasting relationship for long-term economic and business purposes between a foreign investor in the host country.

GDP PER CAPITA

It is a calculation performed to determine the average income received by each of a country's inhabitants; that is, the average income a person receives to subsist.

GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT (GDP)

GDP is the monetary value of final goods and services produced by an economy in a given period. It is a representative indicator that helps measure the growth or decline in the production of goods and services by companies in each country, solely within its own territory.

GROSS PRODUCTION

Value of all goods and services arising from economic activity as a result of operations carried out by economic units, including the marketing margin on resold goods from firms.

IMPORT

commercial action that involves and results in the introduction of foreign products into a given country for the purpose of marketing them.

INPUTS

Goods that are incorporated into the production process of economic units and that, with the work of workers and employees supported by machines, are transformed into other goods or services with greater added value.

INDUSTRY

Refers to the set of operations aimed at obtaining, processing, and transporting raw materials. It is also used to refer to the physical facility or location where these operations are carried out.

LEVEL OF EDUCATION

It presents information on the number of people according to the highest level of studies approved (incomplete/complete primary, complete secondary, upper secondary and higher).

MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES

The manufacturing industry is responsible for the mass production processes of products intended for consumers (for example, most of the technological devices we use on a daily basis).

MINIMUM WAGE

It is the lowest amount that the worker must receive in cash for services rendered in a workday.

OPERATING LICENSE

Authorization granted by the Government for the development of economic activities in a specific establishment.

PATENTS

This is the exclusive right granted by the State over an invention; it is processed before the IMPI (Spanish Industrial Property Institute) through a technical document that describes the technological advancement of the invention.

POPULATION

It is the set of observation units, human beings, establishments, or other types of elements that are going to be studied, in a certain location in time and space.

PRODUCTION VALUE

Refers to the monetary value or amount of work carried out, based on physical progress. Regardless of whether payment has been received from the owner or contractor of the work.

REMUNERATION

These are payments made by the company to plant workers who were hired directly by the company for an indefinite period and who worked for a specific period of time.

SERVICES

A service is the performance of an activity by a service provider. Unlike goods, services are intangible.

UNEMPLOYED POPULATION

People aged 15 and over who were looking for work during the reference week because they were not engaged in any economic activity or job.

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

Percentage of the economically active population (EAP) that is unemployed but is looking for work (see unemployed population).

TRADE

Is a term associated with economic activity, especially buying and selling.

WAGES

Salary is the remuneration, or payment, that a person receives periodically, generally every month, or failing that, every two weeks, from their employer as a result of performing a productive activity.
