

EMPLOYMENT GENERATED PER MONTH


APRIL OF EACH YEAR



BY STATE PROPORTIONALLY TO THE EAP*




DAILY SALARY ASSOCIATED

COMPARISON WITH THE NATIONAL AVERAGE TO APRIL OF EACH YEAR (PESOS PER DAY)




Annual growth of the daily salary associated to workers Annual rate as of April







Q1 2016 - Q4 2021. FIGURES IN MILLIONS OF PEOPLE






Informal Labor Rate*









GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT PER CAPITA PER STATE



2010 AT Q4 2021 - NUMBERS IN CONSTANT PESOS AT 2013 PRICES.











BY SECTOR IN THE STATE OF CHIHUAHUA - ACCUMULATED 2012 TO 2021






FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT IN THE STATE BY COUNTRY

THIRD QUARTER 2021

Based on the Federal Secretary of Economy data, Mexico registered 24.832 billion dollars in Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) as of the third quarter of 2021.

During the same period, Chihuahua received 1,169.6 million dollars, contributing 4.7% of the national total, and the state is ranked 6th as the recipient of FDI after Mexico City, Nuevo Leon, Baja California, Guanajuato and Jalisco.





PRODUCTION VALUE OF THE MAIN METALS








EXPORTS BY MAIN SUBSECTORS



FAMILY REMITTANCE INCOME IN THE STATE OF CHIHUAHUA


2011 TO FIRST QUARTER OF 2022 - FIGURES IN MILLIONS OF DOLLARS



TO FIRST QUARTER OF 2022 - FIGURES IN MILLIONS OF DOLLARS








NUMBER OF VISITORS IN THE STATE2014 - APRIL 2022. FIGURES IN THOUSANDS OF VISITORS











BY TOURISTIC REGION - FIGURES IN MILLIONS OF PESOS


