




## EMPLOYMENT GENERATED PER MONTH AUGUST OF EACH YEAR


## EMPLOYMENT GENERATED PER MONTH JANUARY 2019 - AUGUST 2022




## DAILY SALARY ASSOCIATED WITH IMSS\* INSURED WORKERS







Q1 2016 - Q2 2022. FIGURES IN MILLIONS OF PEOPLE






### Informal Labor Rate\*

The state has the lowest employment rate in the informal sector with a rate of 16.8%, 11.9 points lower than the national rate.





IN THE STATE OF CHIHUAHUA TO Q2 2022













2010 AT Q1 2022 - NUMBERS IN CONSTANT PESOS AT 2013 PRICES.









ANNUAL PERCENTAGE CHANGE - AVERAGE AS OF Q1 2022 (SEASONALLY ADJUSTED SERIES)






### **ECONOMIC ACTIVITY IN CHIHUAHUA**


### **ANNUAL VARIATION OF THE ECONOMIC ACTIVITY IN INDUSTRIAL SECTORS**

BY SECTOR IN THE STATE OF CHIHUAHUA - ACCUMULATED 2012 TO Q2 2022






### FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT IN THE STATE BY COUNTRY

Based on the Federal Secretary of Economy data, Mexico registered 27.5 billion dollars in Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) as of the second quarter of 2022.

During the same period, Chihuahua received 1,153.6 million dollars, contributing 4.2% of the national total, and the state is ranked 5th as the recipient of FDI after Cd. de Mexico, Nuevo Leon, Jalisco and México State.






### **FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT**

## FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT CAPTURED BY STATE Q2 2022 - FIGURES IN BILLIONS OF DOLLARS























### **ANNUAL VARIATION IN FAMILY REMITTANCE INCOME**









**NUMBER OF VISITORS IN THE STATE**2014 - AUGUST 2022. FIGURES IN THOUSANDS OF VISITORS







## **ECONOMIC DISTRIBUTION 2022**BY TOURISTIC REGION - FIGURES IN MILLIONS OF PESOS






### AIRPORT TRAFFIC
